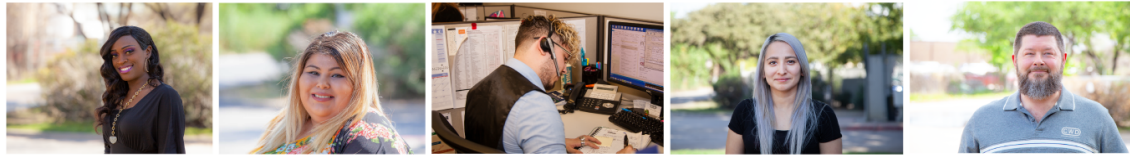

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2024, City Council adopted a Resolution setting a Public Hearing date of May 14, 2024 to receive input on the LUAs and CIP from the public; and,

WHEREAS, notice of the Public Hearing was published on March 28, 2024 in the Herald Banner; and,

WHEREAS, City Council has conducted the required Public Hearing and concurs with the findings in the Study,

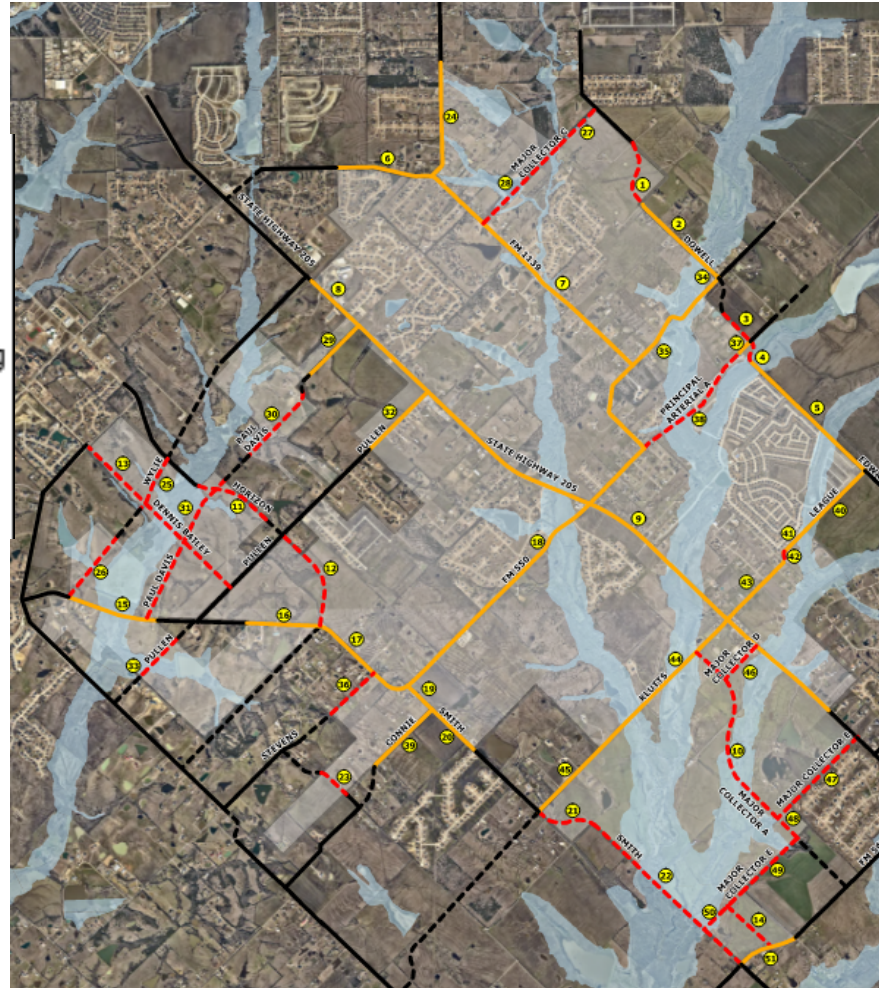

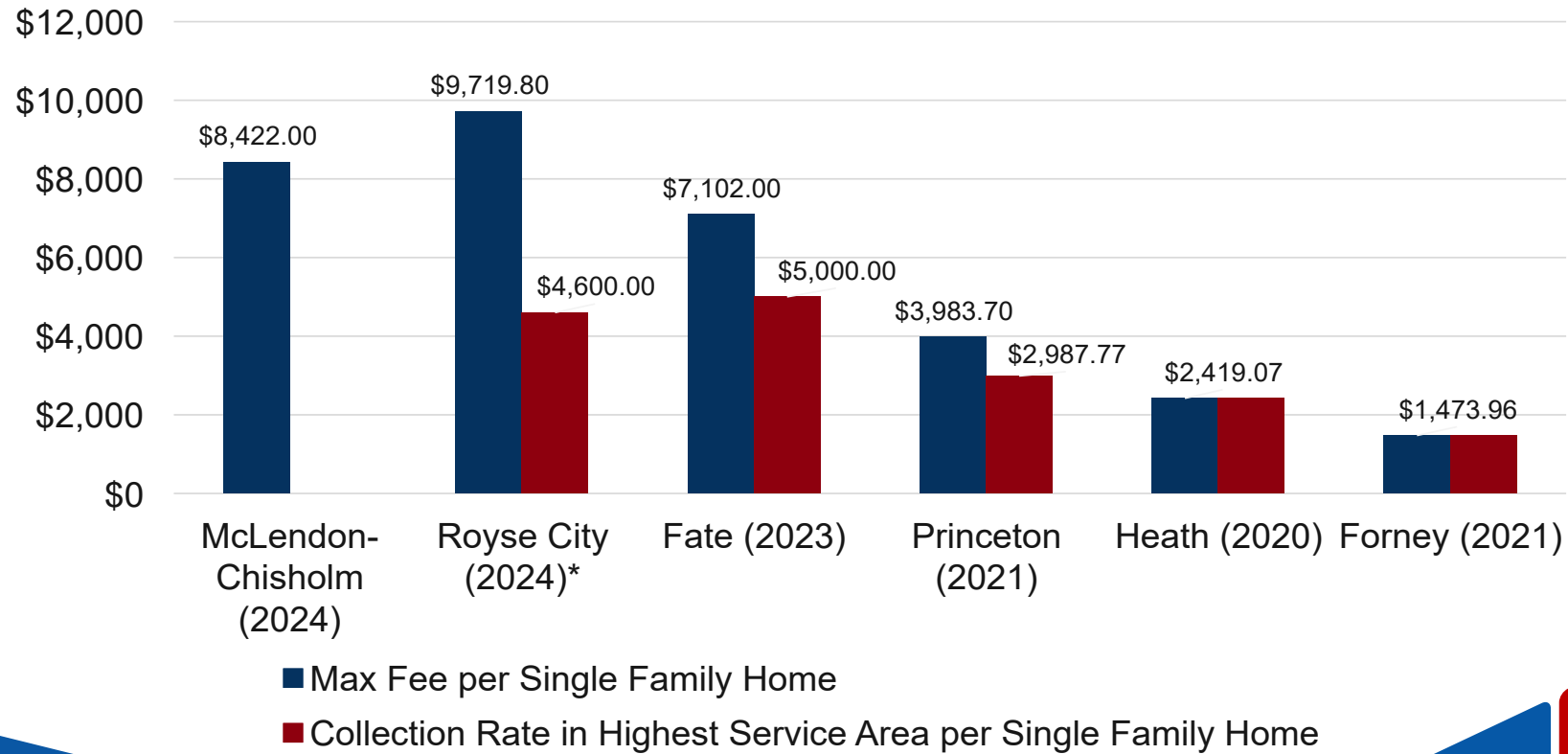

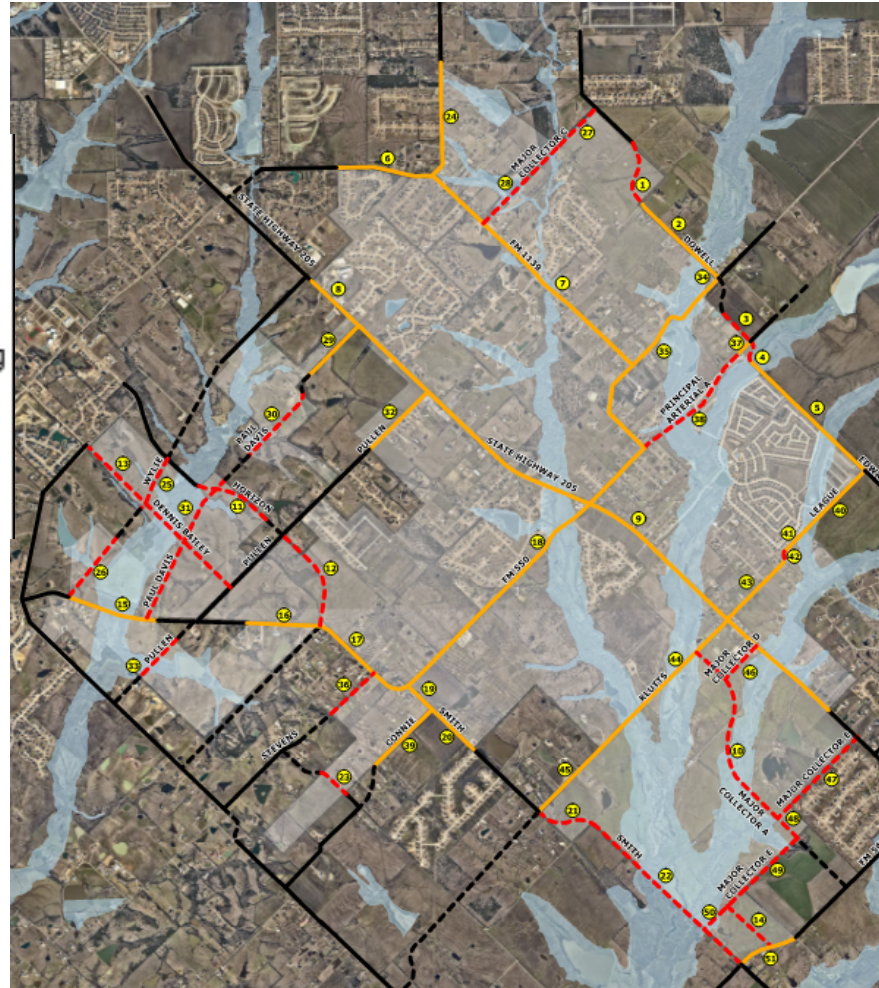

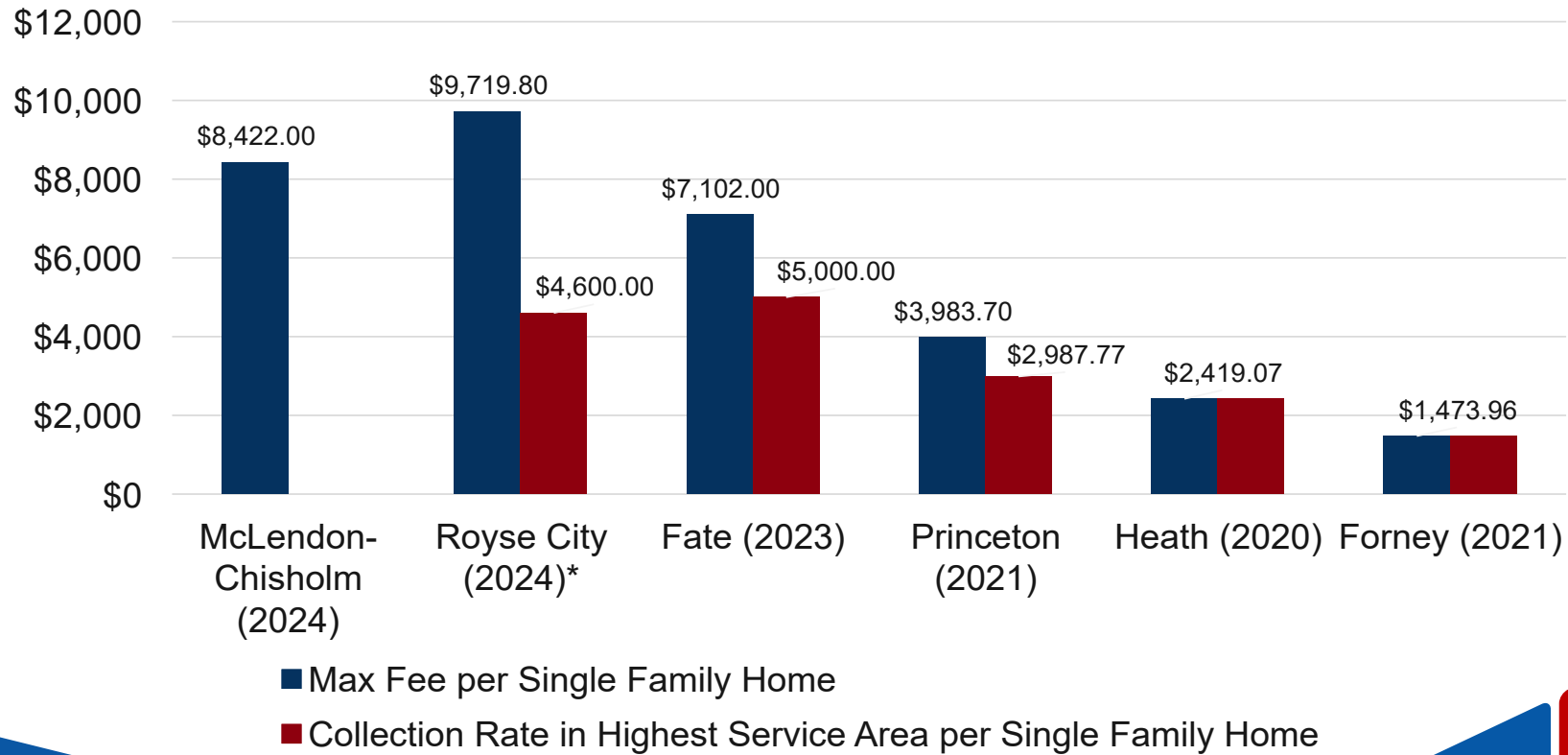

Agenda Item:	Consideration and action of adoption of Maximum Roadway Impact Fees recommendation per single family home in the City of McLendon-Chisholm, Texas.
Fiscal Impact:	Adoption of standardized fees to charge developers for new developments. Kimley-Horn has provided options for consideration.
Background:	The City of McLendon-Chisholm has been working with our contracted consultant, Kimley-Horn, to assess potential Roadway Impact Fees for new developments within the city limits. Kimley-Horn has provided an updated Roadway Impact Fee report and presentation based on Capital Improvements Advisory Committee (CIAC) feedback. The updates were to increase the maximum trip length from 4 miles to 6 miles to support the geography of the city and increasing growth assumptions to reflect development in the pipeline which resulted in an increase of 633 residential units over the next 10 years. Per Kimley-Horn, the maximum fee per single family home that can be collected within the City of McLendon-Chisholm is \$8,422 per home. Comparison data from 5 surrounding cities were examined to determine what percentage of the maximum fee should be charged. Our 10-year growth rate, land use and population projections, resident desires, and the Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) were evaluated to determine what percentage of the maximum fee should be charged for new developments. Kimley-Horn has provided the following options for the committee to consider and recommend to the council: • Option 1 "Competitive Rate" (35% of Max Fee) - \$3,000/single family home

- Less than Fate and Royse City
 - Comparable to Princeton and Heath
- Option 2 “Equal Partnership Rate” (50% of Max Fee) - \$4,211/single family home
 - City partners with development to each pay half the recoverable cost
 - Still less than Fate and comparable to Royse City
- Option 3 “Growth Pays for Growth” (100% of Max Fee) - \$8,422/single family home
 - Development pays for full impact of growth

Members of City Council,

The CIAC held a meeting on 18 June 2024 to consider and acted to make its recommendation to Council on adoption of a roadway impact fee. To make this recommendation the committee reviewed the revised Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and recommendations for adoption of Maximum Roadway Impact Fee structure made by City Staff and Kimley-Horn.

Present at the committee meeting: Mark Kipphut, Chair; Robert Rhode, Vice Chair; Terry Eoff; Thomas Hritz; Jerry Packer; Gyle Dale and Rich Dean. Absent to professional commitments: Chris Freeze.

We thanked Kimley-Horn and City Staff for their careful review of our comments and concerns regarding the initial draft report and subsequent revision of the report based on the issues we highlighted while evaluating the study's land use assumptions, service unit methodology and the plan.

After extensive discussion and debate, the CIAC voted 6-0 (one member abstained) to recommend to Council that it adopt the revised Roadway Impact Fee Assessment Report and set a maximum fee of \$7,500.00 Roadway Impact Fee per new single-family home assessed within the City of McLendon-Chisholm.

The maximum allowable, based on the study conducted by Kimley-Horn, is \$8,422.00 per single family home. In arriving at the \$7,500.00 fee recommendation, the CIAC considered comparison data for surrounding communities and desired impacts and outcomes in setting the fee. The range discussed was \$4,211.00 (50% of Max Fee -- "Equal Partnership Rate") to the maximum of \$8,422.00 (100% of Max Fee -- "Growth Pays for Growth"). The committee was in firm agreement that future growth should pay for future growth and while the recommended fee is higher than in surrounding cities, the CIAC believes that the higher fee structure represents the larger lot development envisioned by the City of McLendon-Chisholm Comprehensive Plan regarding future development.

The CIAC also recommends the city, as part of the adoption process, present a clear and compelling explanation to the citizens for the need to adopt impact fees, how these fees will benefit the citizens of McLendon-Chisholm.

The CIAC dutifully submits its report, June 19th, 2024.

AN RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCLENDON-CHISHOLM, TEXAS, ADOPTING A POLICY FOR A NINETY (90) DAY COOLING OFF PERIOD FOR ITEMS WHICH HAVE BEEN AFFIRMATIVELY DENIED OR DEFEATED PRIOR TO SUCH ITEMS BEING PLACED ON A FUTURE AGENDA; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL OTHER RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT WITH THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City, as a Type A general law municipality, is empowered under the Texas Local Government Code, Section 51.001, to adopt any rule, ordinance or police regulation that is for the good government of the City; and

WHEREAS, efficiency of Council meetings and organization for same is one of the most crucial roles the City Council will undertake; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to assist in effectuating this critically important process, this policy is necessary for the government, interest, welfare, and good order of the City of McLendon-Chisholm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCLENDON-CHISHOLM, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF PREMISES The above and foregoing premises are true and correct legislative determinations and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF A POLICY FOR A NINETY (90) DAY COOLING OFF PERIOD FOR ITEMS WHICH HAVE BEEN AFFIRMATIVELY DENIED OR DEFEATED PRIOR TO SUCH ITEMS BEING PLACED ON A FUTURE AGENDA. The Policy for a ninety (90) day cooling off period for items which have been defeated or affirmatively denied is hereby adopted by the City Council of the City of McLendon-Chisholm and shall state as follows:

Reintroduction of a Prior Defeated or Affirmatively Denied Action

1. A motion, ordinance, or resolution previously defeated or affirmatively denied at a City Council meeting during the previous ninety (90) calendar days, from the date the motion, ordinance, or resolution was defeated or affirmatively denied, may not be reintroduced for reconsideration unless a substantive change to the item or in the circumstances thereof has occurred, or its reconsideration is required by other State or Federal law.
2. A “substantive change,” pursuant to (a), is defined as a significant modification, reduction, or expansion in the nature and scope of the defeated item as determined by the City Administrator. If a substantive change is determined to exist, the City Administrator shall

state, at open meeting, the reason(s) for this determination prior to the approval of the agenda on which the defeated item is reintroduced.

3. The City Council may remove the restriction in (a) via a two-thirds (2/3) vote.

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS This Resolution shall be cumulative of all provisions of Resolutions of the City except where the provisions of this Resolution are in direct conflict with the provisions of such Resolutions, in which event the conflicting provisions of such Resolutions are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of McLendon-Chisholm, Texas, that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Resolution are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Resolution should be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Resolution, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation in this Resolution of such unconstitutional phrases, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.
